Allow for 2 hours; \$5 per student (15 person minimum).

- * **Petting Zoo, Nature Walk & Frontier Cabin** (Enjoy our Farm animal friends, the beautiful forest and discover the “little cabin in the woods”). 45 min.; \$3 per person.
- * **Country Store Museum & Barn Museum** (Experience yesteryear’s “one-stop shop” and the development of farming, domestics and medicines). One-hour; \$4 per person.
