Eric Carle was born in Syracuse, New York in 1929. As a young boy, he loved school and especially enjoyed putting his creativity to work while painting during art class. His parents were German immigrants and right before the start of World War II, his family moved back to Germany; he was just six years old. He did not enjoy school in Germany as much as he did in the United States, but he loved visiting his German relatives' farms and taking long walks in the summer to study nature and its beautiful creations.

Carle experienced many trials throughout the course of World War II and its aftermath, but he remained intent on his goal to become an artist. He graduated from high school and eventually studied graphic art at the Akademie der bildenden Künste...

The mammals are the class of vertebrate animals characterized by the presence of mammary glands, which in females produce milk for the nourishment of young.

Placentals

The placentals are distinguished from other mammals in that the fetus is nourished during pregnancy via a placenta.

Marsupials

Marsupials are mammals in which the female typically has a pouch (called the marsupium) in which it rears its young through early infancy. They differ from placental mammals in their reproductive traits.

Monotremes

Monotremes are mammals that lay eggs instead of giving birth to live young like marsupials and placental mammals.

It is not new to elementary teachers that kids have a natural curiosity about animals.

Dogs, cats, horses, and dinosaurs dominate many kid's attention and TV and the computer is a great source of information. It can be a challenge for teachers to keep up with all the information coming in, so they can help with interpretation and evaluation of the information. Outside a course or two, and maybe the same sources their students are exposed to, most teachers don't get a chance to learn enough to stay ahead of their kids' knowledge.

It's also possible to leverage students' interest in animals to provide instruction in other subjects like language and mathematics.

One possible way to spark interest is to know that about 2 million animal species have been described by science, but there may be another...
